

**Course Description:**

**Rigger Competence Assessment**

This Product is for personnel that wish to become OPITO certified competent riggers having successfully completed the OPITO Rigger Initial Training Standard and Rigger Workplace Experience Logbook or possess sufficient and relevant work experience to be eligible for the OPITO Rigger Competence Assessment.

**Course Details**

**Guided Learning Hours:**

The learners will be expected to carry out two rigging and lifting operations for their assessment and be required to assist other learners on two rigging and lifting operations.

- 1.5 hours per rigging and lifting operation
- 1.5 hours allowed for the written test

**Learning Outcomes/ Key Topics:**

**OIS 202 – Plan, Prepare, Lift and Move Loads (Theory) :**

1. Preparation for lifting and moving loads
2. The lifting, moving, lowering and landing of a load

**OIS 200 - Plan, Prepare, Lift and Move Loads (Practical)**

1. Preparation for lifting and moving loads
2. The lifting, moving, lowering and landing of a load



**Pre-requisites:**

**Possibility 1**

- A valid OPITO-approved Rigger Initial Training Certificate awarded within the previous 32 months; AND
- A fully completed and valid OPITO Rigger Workplace Experience Logbook and supporting evidence for each of the 50 tasks\*, such as a copy of the lifting plan, permit or toolbox based on the OPITO Rigger Initial Training Standard and Rigger Workplace Experience Logbook requirements. The logbook must be signed as true and valid by the employing company head of discipline or the employing company discipline manager and confirmed by the Centre as being present and correct prior to assessment taking place.

\*Supporting evidence is not required for learners who completed the Initial Training Standard (previously Stage 1) between February 29th, 2020, and February 28th, 2022.

**OR**

- If a learner completed the Rigger Initial Training Standard (previously Stage 1) **between November 1st 2021, and November 30th 2023**, a fully completed and valid OPITO Rigger Workplace Experience Logbook and supporting evidence for each of the 10 tasks, such as a copy of the lifting plan, permit or toolbox talk, based on the OPITO Rigger Initial Training Standard and Rigger Workplace Experience Logbook requirements.

The logbook must be signed as true and valid by the employing company head of discipline or the employing company discipline manager and confirmed by the Centre as being present and correct prior to assessment taking place.

**Possibility 2**

- Learner must possess a valid OPITO approved Rigger Competence or Rigger Competence Re-Assessment Certificate awarded within the previous thirty (30) months.

**Possibility 3**

- Evidence that they have been assessed as competent and have achieved an equivalent qualification/ certification by a nationally recognized awarding body, awarded within the previous 30 months; **AND**
- A copy of the alternative certification must be provided together with the list of topics covered from the awarding institution to verify the equivalency of the learner’s qualification/ certification.

**Minimum Learners per Class : 02**

**Maximum Learners per Class : 04**
